part 1

1. Establish cooperation and collect experiences in the field of grey publishing at Norwegian universities and university colleges
2. Test models for publishing of grey literature (electronic and print)
3. Test systems for long-time storage of electronic full text documents
4. Conduct a survey of problems related to publishing of grey literature

The objectives of the publishing project

part 2

5. Establish recommendations for future organisation and production models, storage and retrieval systems, and perhaps future projects
6. Publish results of the project and arrange a conference where the results are presented and future development is discussed.
7. The main focus of the project is not layout and graphic profile

Grey literature

From: International Journal on grey literature

- Grey Literature is that which is produced at all levels by government, academia, business and industry, both in print and electronic formats, but which is not controlled by commercial publishing interests, and where publishing is not the primary business activity of the organization. Grey Literature supports the research process and encompasses a vast range of information types such as policy documents, corporate reports, data sets from academic and corporate research, university theses and dissertations, technical reports and conference proceedings. Despite being of great importance to researchers, such information has often been hard to identify and access, and thus undervalued.

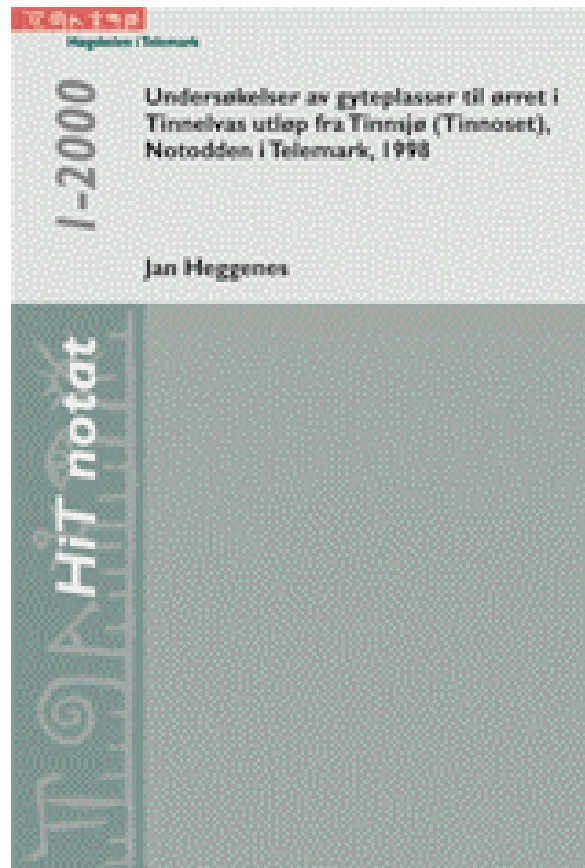
